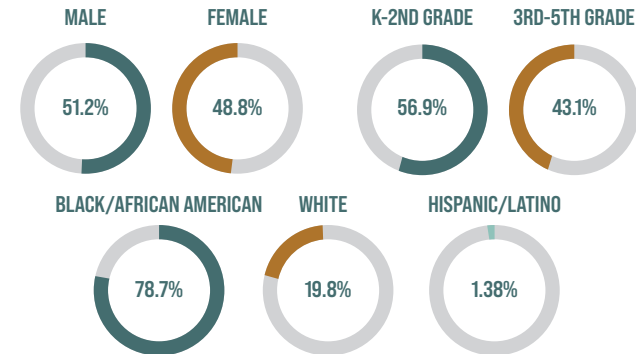

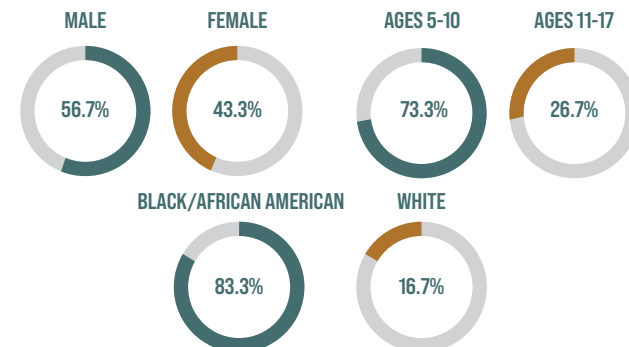

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

INDIVIDUAL COUNSELING

THE CAMILLA FOUNDATION PROVIDES CLINICAL INDIVIDUAL COUNSELING. CLIENTS INTERESTED IN ONGOING COUNSELING SERVICES MAY MEET WITH A LICENSED, PRE-LICENSED, OR GRADUATE LEVEL/IN-TRAINING COUNSELOR. UNLICENSED COUNSELORS WORK WITH CLIENTS UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A LICENSED, CERTIFIED SUPERVISOR ON A WEEKLY BASIS.

THIS SUPERVISION IS DISCLOSED TO CLIENTS AND GUARDIANS VERBALLY, AND BY OBTAINING A SIGNED INFORMED CONSENT OF SUCH, PRIOR TO THE INITIATION OF SERVICES. **COUNSELORS WORK WITH PARENTS, GUARDIANS, FAMILIES TO ESTABLISH GOALS FOR COUNSELING AND WORK WITH THE CLIENT TO MEET THE GOALS.**



SEL GROUP COUNSELING

SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL LEARNING (SEL) IS AN EDUCATIONAL METHOD THAT HELPS CHILDREN AND YOUTH DEVELOP SKILLS TO MANAGE THEIR EMOTIONS, BUILD RELATIONSHIPS, AND MAKE RESPONSIBLE DECISIONS. SEL CAN HELP YOUNG PEOPLE GROW INTO HEALTHY ADULTS AND SUCCEED IN SCHOOL. RESEARCH HAS SHOWN THAT SEL CAN HAVE A SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ON CHILDREN'S BEHAVIOR AND ATTITUDES TOWARDS SCHOOL. FOR EXAMPLE, ONE STUDY (BAPTISTE ET AL., 2022) FOUND THAT CHILDREN WHO ATTENDED AN AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM WITH AN SEL CURRICULUM SHOWED SIGNIFICANT INCREASES IN EMPATHY AND SELF-MANAGEMENT.

THE BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB AND BULLOCH COUNTY RECREATION AND PARKS ARE TWO LOCAL NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS THAT INCORPORATE SEL CURRICULUM PROVIDED BY THE CAMILLA FOUNDATION, INC. COMPETENCIES INCLUDE: SETTING AND ACHIEVING GOALS, UNDERSTANDING AND MANAGING EMOTIONS, POSITIVE RELATIONSHIPS, EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION, AND RESPONSIBLE DECISION-MAKING.



SUCCESS STORIES



SAM

SAM (WHOSE NAME AND PHOTO HAVE BEEN CHANGED TO PROTECT HIS IDENTITY) **STRUGGLED WITH EXPRESSING HIS EMOTIONS, ENDURED SIGNIFICANT BULLYING, AND HAD VERY LITTLE CONFIDENCE AND LOW SELF-ESTEEM.** SAM HAD DIFFICULTY

COMMUNICATING HIS THOUGHTS AND FEELINGS EFFECTIVELY, CREATING BARRIERS IN HIS ABILITY TO CONNECT AND FORM MEANINGFUL RELATIONSHIPS WITH HIS PEERS. THROUGH WEEKLY COUNSELING SESSIONS, **TAILORED TO HIS UNIQUE NEEDS**, SAM LEARNED VALUABLE COPING SKILLS TO HELP HIM PROCESS AND EXPRESS HIS EMOTIONS SO THAT HE COULD NAVIGATE WITH BULLYING SITUATIONS EFFECTIVELY. ADDITIONALLY, HE LEARNED VARIOUS SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL TOOLS TO ENHANCE HIS SOCIAL INTERACTIONS AND FOSTER STRONGER RELATIONSHIPS. OVER THE SCHOOL YEAR, SAM BLOSSOMED INTO A **CONFIDENT, RESILIENT, AND EMPOWERED INDIVIDUAL** WHO DEVELOPED A SENSE OF BELONGING AND DISCOVERED HIS UNIQUE STRENGTHS AND TALENTS. THANKS TO A REFERRAL FROM A CARING STAFF MEMBER, SAM BEGAN TO OPEN UP AND DEVELOP A TRUSTING RELATIONSHIP WITH HIS THERAPIST WHO ENGAGED HIM IN **CHILD-CENTERED PLAY THERAPY (CCPT)** TO ADDRESS THE NEGATIVE CONSEQUENCES OF BULLYING THAT HE HAD EXPERIENCED.

WITH THE COMMUNITY'S GENEROSITY AND OUR COUNSELORS' PRACTICALITY THAT ALL CHILDREN ARE UNIQUE AND WORTHY OF RESPECT, THE CAMILLA FOUNDATION, INC OFFERS LIFE-CHANGING CLINICAL SERVICES LIKE CCPT TO BRING ABOUT HEALING AND GROWTH.



ALEX

BEFORE COUNSELING, ALEX (WHOSE NAME AND PHOTO HAVE BEEN CHANGED TO PROTECT HER IDENTITY) **WAS OFTEN INVOLVED WITH DISCIPLINARY REFERRALS.** ALEX WAS EXPERIENCING SEVERAL SITUATIONS IN HER FAMILY THAT CREATED OVERWHELMING FEELINGS OF ANXIETY, AND FEAR. AT TIMES, ALEX'S EMOTIONS WOULD BE TRIGGERED IN THE SCHOOL SETTING, AND SHE WOULD ACT OUT WITH BEHAVIORS THAT DISRUPTED CLASS AND SOMETIMES CREATED CONFLICT OR HARM WITH OTHER STUDENTS OR TEACHERS. SINCE ALEX STARTED COUNSELING, SHE HAS **LEARNED TO IDENTIFY HER FEELINGS, CONTROL HER FEELINGS AND USE HER WORDS TO ASK FOR HELP** AND EXPRESS WHAT SHE NEEDS. THIS HAS RESULTED IN A DECREASE IN REFERRALS TO THE PRINCIPAL'S OFFICE AND MORE TIME FOR ALEX TO STAY ENGAGED WITH HER PEERS IN ACTIVITIES BOTH INSIDE AND OUTSIDE OF THE CLASSROOM.

THROUGH THE **BUILDING OF OPPORTUNITIES IN OUT-OF-SCHOOL TIME (BOOST) GRANT AND LOCAL DONATIONS**, FUNDS WERE AVAILABLE FOR ALEX TO RECEIVE COUNSELING SERVICES FREE OF CHARGE DURING AFTER-SCHOOL HOURS, ENSURING THE THERAPEUTIC PROCESS CONTINUED SEAMLESSLY.



THE CAMILLA FOUNDATION IS NORMALIZING THE CONVERSATION SURROUNDING MENTAL HEALTH THROUGH ENGAGING COMMUNITY LEADERS AND FAMILIES IN AN ON-GOING DIALOGUE TO PROMOTE MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS IN SCHOOLS, BUSINESSES, GARDEN CLUBS, CIVIC ORGANIZATIONS AND THE COMMUNITY AT LARGE. THROUGH EXPERT PANEL DISCUSSIONS, WELLNESS FAIRS AND SHARED EXPERIENCES, OUR CONVERSATIONS SERVE AS AN IMPETUS FOR FOSTERING A SUPPORTIVE NETWORK THAT ACTIVELY CONTRIBUTES TO THE BETTERMENT OF MENTAL WELLNESS IN BULLOCH COUNTY.

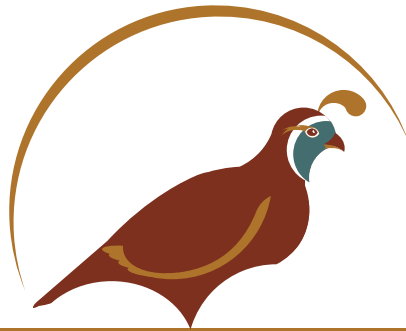
